PLEASE NOTE: The 3rd class of the Children's and Adult Hunter divisions will be the 1st round of the M&S Classic. A separate class, not included with in the division, will be the 2nd round M&S Classic. All Derbies will run under the Hunt and Go format (similar to back-to-back trips).

The following classes are NEHC rated: Walk Trot Equitation, Short Stirrup Equitation & Hunters, Children's Equitation & Hunters, PreChild Hunter, Modified Adult Equitation & Hunters, Adult Equitation & Hunters, Child/Adult Jumper, Open Jumper, Color Breed Pleasure, Hunter Pleasure, NEHC Open Pleasure, NEHC Adult & Junior Medals.

All classes are CHSA rated EXCEPT: CHJA, M&S and NEHC Medals and Classics, NEHC Pleasure; Puddle Jumpers

All classes are CHJA rated EXCEPT: CHSA, M&S and NEHC Medals and Classics, all Pleasure classes; Beginner 11 and over Equitation; WTC Equitation; Puddle Jumpers

Rules & Regulations 1. Every class offered herein which is recognized by the CHJA/CHSA/NEHC will be conducted and judged in accordance with the current CHJA/CHSA/NEHC Rules. To show in CHJA/NEHC Medal classes, riders MUST be members. In order to compete for CHJA/CHSA/NEHC annual year -end awards, the owner of the horse or pony must be a member of the CHJA/CHSA/NEHC and the horse or pony must be registered with the CHJA/ CHSA/NEHC. A copy of the Rule Books, class specifications, Medal class specifications, and membership applications are available at the show secretary's office or online. 2. Every animal entered for competition shall be under the control of show management; but Well A Way Farm will in no way be responsible for any loss, accident or damage that may occur by fire or otherwise and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor, spectator, trainer and attendant hold Well A Way Farm, and its members, employees and agents harmless for any loss or damage that may occur to any persons, animals or property at the show. 3. If any questions or disputes arise, same will be referred to the steward & show committee, whose decision shall be final. 4. Exhibitors are responsible for having accurate and current memberships for all organizations which require the same. Any fines levied against the horse show for incorrect exhibitor memberships shall be the responsibility of the exhibitor. 5. \$50 Fee for any returned checks, or unpaid entries that must be billed. 6. Entries close 24 Hours Prior to show. Post entries \$25. The listed officials have been invited to attend, but WAWF Reserves the right to vary or add to this list.

Directions:

From the West and East

Take I-84 to Exit 39 (Farmington Route 4) follow Route 4 to Route 10, Take a right on Route 10 which is Waterville Road. Continue straight for 5.5 miles to intersection of rte. 44. Cross rte. 44, continuing straight onto Nod Rd. 3 for miles. At end of Nod Rd, turn right onto rte. 185. After ¼ mile, bear left onto East Weatogue St. Continue straight approx. 1.5 miles to stop sign, bear right continuing on Terry Plain Rd. The farm is approx. 1 mile on right.

From the North

I-91 South to Exit 40 (Route 20) Follow to Route 10. Take Route 10 South (Salmon Brook St.) 5.5 miles, turning left onto rte. 315/Tariffville Rd. (there is a stop light) 1/3 mi. turn right onto Terry Plain Rd. At stop sign (approx. 1 mi) bear right. The farm is almost immediately on your left.

From the South

Take I-91or rte 9 North to I-84 West. Exit 39 (Farmington Route 4) and follow directions from East/West.
