#### DERBY CLASSES –HUNT AND GO FORMAT

NEHC "C", CHJA, CHSA Recognized

**Class 301 and 302 open to amateur adults and junior riders** to be shown over a course of ten fences at 2'-2'3" with height not to exceed 2'6" for class 301 and 2'6" for class 303 with higher options.

**Class 303 is open to all riders.** Class specs same as classes 301 and 302 with fence height being 2'9" with higher options.

The first round judged on performance, hunter pace and style, quality and substance, and movement. The course should include at least one in and out, one bending line and one unrelated distance. The obstacles are to simulate those found in a hunt field. Natural obstacles may be used. All riders will be invited back for the second round, a handy hunter round of six to eight fences which may include at least 2 of the following: trot jump, tight turn option, clever option for jump approach, halt and/or back. To be judged on style, brilliance, and handiness. Judges will adhere to USHJA Hunter Derby rules for scoring. The score will be a total of the two rounds. The exhibitor will be allowed to ride the first round, leave the ring, and then return for the handy round. Both rounds can be ridden back-to-back. To fill a class, at least four horses must compete.

Heights may be combined to reach four entries.

**CHJA MEDAL CLASSES**

Riders must be current members of CHJA. The class consists of 2 phases- fences and flat – each counting for 50%. At least 3 riders must complete both phases, same horse/rider combination for both phases. May enter only one Medal class per show. Judge may require additional testing, using current USEF tests 1-8 for Children and Pony Medal, test 1-19 for Junior and Adult Medals.

**211. NEHC HUNT SEAT MEDAL CLASS:** Open to Junior Members of the New England Horsemen's Council who have not reached their 18th birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not exceeding 3'3". One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion (USEF tests 1-19). To fill a class at least 3 competitors must complete the course. One win required to qualify for the finals.

**212. NEHC ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER SEAT MEDAL:** Open to Adult Amateur Members of the NEHC. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3'. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion (USEF current tests 1-19). To fill a class, at least 3 competitors must complete the course.

**MHJ MEDAL CLASSES: ENTRY FEE \$40**

At least two riders must complete the designated course for points to count. 10pts required to qualify for finals. Once qualified, riders may continue to compete in the class.

**308. MHJ SHORT STIRRUP MEDAL:** Fences 18". Open to riders who have not reached their 13th birthday as of Dec. 1st.

**309. MHJ MINI-MEDAL:** Fences 2'6". Open to riders who have not reached their 15th birthday as of Dec. 1st. Riders may cross-enter the Children's Equitation Medal but can only compete in either the Mini-Medal OR Children's Medal at finals.

All exhibitors must be amateurs in accordance with GR1306 Fence heights to be set at 3'-3'3" (.95) Riders may not compete in any other class at the same competition where fences exceed 1.15m (3'9"). *CHAMPIONSHIP AND RESERVE AWARDED*

## RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Entries close 2 pm the day before show date. Post entries accepted after the entries are closed for an additional \$25.00 each.
2. Stalls may be available for the day for a fee of \$40. Call 860-280-8659 to reserve a stall by 5pm the day before the show.
3. The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel, vary or combine, any classes if in its judgment, the entries so indicate. If the area of the courtesy circle is to be restricted by a mandatory line, the line will be indicated on the diagram and a corresponding barrier will be erected on the course.
4. No entry fee will be returned because of withdrawal of a contestant after closing of entries except where an entry, through injury or illness, is unable to exhibit. In such cases, all unused entry fees will be returned upon receipt of a veterinarian certificate.
5. Every class offered herein which is recognized by the USHJA, M&S, CHJA, CHSA and/or NEHC will be conducted and judged in accordance with the current USHJA, M&S, CHJA, CHSA and/or NEHC rules. To compete for USHJA, PHA, CHJA, CHSA and/or NEHC annual horse awards, the owner of the horse or pony must be a member of the USHJA, PHA, CHJA, CHSA and/or NEHC and the horse or pony must be registered with the CHJA, CHSA and/or NEHC. To compete in CHJA and NEHC Medal classes, riders must be members of those respective organizations.
6. New England Horseman's Council Rules shall supersede any State Rules for NEHC points to count.
7. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. ***The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation.*** Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
8. To be eligible for stake classes, horses must have competed in a least one other class over fences in that division.
9. Well A Way Farm Stables, LLC. will in no way be responsible for any damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of every entry that each exhibitor shall hold The Well A Way Farm Stables, LLC., and The Well A Way Farm Show Committee harmless for any loss or accident which may occur. Should any questions or disputes arise, it shall be referred to the Show Committee whose decision shall be final.
11. The Committee reserves the right to change the location of classes, to alter courses and/or fences, and/or to change the show schedule as it seems necessary.

12. Prize money will be applied towards entry fees. If prize money is not applied, and the error is detected after the show, then that entry shall receive a credit at the next Well A Way Farm Horse Show they attend. The Horse Show will not stop payment or duplicate checks for lost prize money.

I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the organizations and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Competition, sport, or the organizations. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of organization rules are governed by the laws of the State, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.
